

FAIRY PARTY

As the kids come in I can paint their faces with sparkling fairy crowns or butterflies. I also have butterfly tattoos as well, which works quite well for fairies.

For an additional \$25.00 we can add hair wraps and hair beads, nail polish, and sparkle makeup

For an additional \$25.00 we can bring our dress-up trunk of wonderful things – from little plastic high heels to sparkle dresses, to feather boas.

DECORATIONS

I have yards of tulle in pink, paper flowers, rainbow streamers, sparkling stars, and spinning pinwheel flowers for outside. We can do a nice assortment of general decorations for \$35.00 rental/set up fee.

Balloons –

We have various pastel shades to choose from or bright rainbow colors - I can make rainbow arches for the entrance way and I have enormous sun, moon, and star balloons in mylar. – priced upon request

Bright colorful 11 inch balloons - \$12.00 per dz

Latex Heart balloons - \$1.25 each

Flower balloons - \$5.00 each (these are specialty flowers, made up of one 16" flower balloon with two small 5" balloons for the centers, 3 11" balloons around the flower base, and two 5" heart balloons for the leaves on the ribbon stem)

Assorted mylars – from little birds, to flowers...priced upon request – \$3.50 – 7.00

CRAFTS

Fairy dust – the children are given little tins to decorate and then to fill with their own mixture of fairy dust and natural things – \$3.50 each

Fairy dust necklace- full of wishing dust and comes with wishing rules - \$3.50 each

We could make little flower fairies - wee little dolls with dresses made of petals - \$2.00 each

We can make them a house - \$2.50 each

Magic wands - made with beads and sparkling mylar streamers - \$2.00 each

We can also do fairy paper dolls - each child is given a paper doll to color and decorate with stickers. We take a Polaroid picture of the children cut the head out and glue it onto the paper doll. We can put a magnet on the back so that it can be displayed around the house. - \$2.50 each

GAMES

Flower hopping - Each little fairy stands on a flower (a hula-hoop that is placed on the ground). When I play music the little fairies must fly around outside the flowers, but when the music stops the fairies must jump into a hula hoop....We start removing hula hoops one by one, until all the fairies are squishing into one hula hoop - it's very funny and the kids love it.

Saving the field mouse - the mean owl (that's me) has stolen the little field mouse and the fairies must help to get him back. The children try to sneak up and steal the field mouse away, but if I see them I might swoop down on them, chasing them back to the beginning line.

Where is the fairy gold? - The fairies sit in a circle (the fairy ring) and one person sits in the middle - the fairies on the outside pass the fairy gold behind their backs while singing a little song - "fairy gold fairy gold where are you, fairy gold fairy gold, tell me true, fairy gold fairy gold, are you here, fairy gold, fairy gold I think you're there" When the children sing there the fairy in the middle points to a child whom she thinks might have the gold...if she is wrong the person who has the gold and she switch...if she is right she gets to choose the next person to come into the center.

Sleeping fairies – the children sleep while the fairy puts fairy kisses on their sleeping bodies (the kisses are little m&m's)

Fairy Dancing – the fairies dance to music, but turn into statues when the fairy music stops...one child takes a feather duster to clean the statues...but if you giggle you must sit down.

Fairy races – using dice the children are only allowed to move when their number is rolled on the big dice.

Fairy Pop Up- using a parachute (a plain bed sheet), the little colored fairies are placed in the middle. . Then have the kids hold the edges of the sheet place one of each fairy in the middle...now as if the sheet was a parachute have the kids ripple the sheet up and down...the fairies will begin to dance and pop around....

see which fairy color can stay in the middle the longest, after they have all popped out, have the kids gather them all, throw them in the center, and start again.

Fairy Hide and go seek - How many fairies can dance on the head of a pin - this game answers that - choose one fairy to be the hider...all the other fairies put their heads down and count to 20 or some such number. The little fairy then hides. When the fairy is hidden all the other little fairies go rushing about to find her. When they do, they silently squish in with her in her hiding place (no alerting the others to her whereabouts), the fairies continue hunting until everyone is squished in one place. The first girl to squish in is the next fairy to hide...not the last one (as I learned...they will all pretend not to see her and the game goes on forever!)

Fairy kisses - everyone lies down on the ground and sleeps...the queen fairy leaves little fairy kisses on the still bodies (m&m's)...after everyone has received their kisses the kids can slowly wake up and eat the m&m's that they find.

GOODIE BAGS

Fairy dust – tiny little glass bottles filled with fairy dust, nestled in a little tulle sack tied with a ribbon. Each has a little story about how the fairy dust is collected - \$3.50 each

Tiny little candies - such as nerds or mini M&M's - we can make a special label for the mini M&M's with your daughter's name - \$1.50 for specialty M&M's (nerds and other little candies market value) or we could turn fruit roll ups into little flowers - \$2.00 each

Bubbles might be fun – we can personalize bubbles with your child's name - \$1.50 per Bottle of bubbles

Fairy wings - these run about \$9.00 per pair but they might be a very nice party favor with a tiny bit of candy.

Fairy tale books are nice - Dover makes a small paperback called thrift classics; we can wrap them with a little something else on top - \$2.50 for wrapping and a little candy on top. Price for book is TBD (market price)

Fairy tattoos - a little book of fairy tattoos from Dover - \$2.00

Small butterfly tattoos - \$1.00

Body glitter to add some sparkle - \$2.00 each

Little stuffed animals - market price (depends on what you want)

Rings - big sparkly ones - \$2.00 each

Necklaces - \$1.50 each

Simple bead necklaces - .50 each

Simple rings - .50 each

Ring pops - .40 each

Candy bracelets - .35 each

Candy necklaces - .50 each
